EU Commission Decision on Statistical Reporting for Migration-Related IT Systems

Executive Summary

The European Commission adopted a Decision laying down rules for the production of statistics related to migration-management IT systems.

The Decision implements provisions of **Regulation (EU) 2024/1358**, establishing how statistical data must be structured and reported.

It defines categories of statistical information derived from large-scale EU information systems used in migration and border management.

The statistics are intended to support **monitoring of migration flows, evidence-based policymaking, and application of Regulation (EU) 2024/1351**.

The Decision specifies that **eu-LISA produces monthly statistics** based on defined data categories.

Key Facts

- The Decision establishes **rules for statistical reporting related to EU migration-management IT systems**.
 - It operates as an **implementing act under Article 12(3) of Regulation (EU) 2024/1358**.
 - The Decision defines the **statistical content and structure** of reports.

Key Findings

- The Decision primarily defines **how statistics must be structured and produced**, rather than operational rules for migration systems.
 - The statistical framework is **directly linked to the implementation of Regulation (EU) 2024/1358**.
 - The data collected aims to support **monitoring of migration flows and policy evaluation**.
 - Statistical outputs are **generated monthly by eu-LISA**.
 - The statistical categories correspond to **different migration-related situations addressed across Articles 1–5**.
 - The Decision contributes to **evidence-based policymaking linked to Regulation (EU) 2024/1351**.
